Day Five – Acetate Christmas Card



1. Cut a piece of clear cardstock (acetate sheet) to 10½cmX21cm.
2. Score at 10½cm and fold the card in half, using a bone folder to create a clean, crisp fold.
3. Cut a piece of copy paper or Whisper White cardstock to 10½cmX21cm. Fold in half and set aside.
4. Emboss the front of the clear card as desired. I used a Christmas ornaments Cuttlebug embossing folder.
5. Apply 2-way glue to the back of the card front, inside the design of your embossed areas. Add the dyed glitter over the glue and if necessary, use a paddlepop stick or similar to gently press the glitter into the glue.
6. Insert the folded copy paper/cardstock into the card, aligning the fold with the fold in the clear card.
7. Take a length of Kiwi Kiss ribbon (approx. 27cm) and use it to attach the insert to the card, tying a knot at the front of the card. Position the knot approx. 2cm from the top of the card.
8. Stamp your sentiment on Whisper White cardstock and punch out with the Large Oval Punch.
9. Punch a Scallop Oval from Kiwi Kiss cardstock and adhere your sentiment oval to the centre of it.
10. Attach the Scallop Oval to the bottom right of the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
