

Day Three – Fold Down Christmas Card



1. Cut a piece of Garden Green cardstock to 19½cmX16½cm (16½cm is the height of the card)
2. Fold the card in half. Mark the card front with a grey lead pencil at the top (¾cm from the centre fold) and right side (9cm from top). Score the card front diagonally from the top mark to the side mark. Fold along the score line, bringing the top right corner down towards the front of the card, as shown in picture above.
3. Cut a piece of Designer Series Paper (I've used the Ruby Red houndstooth pattern from Holiday Wishes DSP) to 16cm X 9¼cm. Mark at ¾cm from the top left corner and 8¾cm from the top right corner. Cut diagonally between the two marks. Adhere this piece to the card front, leaving a small border around the bottom and two sides, as shown in picture above.
4. Cut a piece of Sahara Sand cardstock to 8½cm square. Cut in half diagonally and emboss using the Cuttlebug Swiss Dots embossing folder or similar. Adhere to the triangle created in the card front by folding down the top edge (as shown in picture above).
5. Cut a piece of Very Vanilla cardstock 5¼cmX8cm. Stamp "Jingle All The Way" sentiment at the bottom centre using Chocolate Chip ink. Cut a piece of Chocolate Chip cardstock 8cmX6cm. Adhere the vanilla cardstock sentiment to the Chocolate Chip cardstock. Adhere this entire panel to the card front, aligning with the bottom edge of the DSP, approx. 1½cm from the right edge of the card front.
6. Cut a piece of Ruby Red cardstock to 9cmX16cm. Adhere to the inside of the base card, leaving a small border around each edge.
7. Create two Holly Leaves using Old Olive cardstock. View my online video tutorial to see how I did this. Adhere your Holly Leaves to the card front, positioning as shown above. Thread some Linen Thread through a Riding Hood Red button and tie a knot. Adhere to the card front, between the Holly Leaves, using Glue Dots.
